

Certificate – Native American Art with emphasis on Chippewa Cree Art

PHILOSOPHY:

The Native American Art with an emphasis on Chippewa Cree Art Certificate is committed to the development of accomplished visual artists who are rooted in their Chippewa Cree culture as well as the Northern Plains Native American cultural life. The certificate provides basic skills necessary to create successful paintings, drawings and a wide variety of traditional Native Arts. Students will learn the history of the Chippewa Cree and regional arts in the Northern Plains. Additionally, students will gain the graphic design and computer skills necessary to market their art through various venues such as websites and social media.

EXPECTED LEARNER OUTCOMES:

Students will:

1. Demonstrate growing competence in Chippewa Cree Arts and Native Arts such as design, color theory and composition.
2. Create Chippewa Cree art in its various forms, including painting, drawing, tanning hide, parfleche, beadwork, dressmaking, drums, tipi making, or hand drums.
3. Demonstrate knowledge of Chippewa Cree culture, especially visual art.
4. Create marketing materials for promotion of art work.
